Dorm Policies

All individuals staying in a dorm or room at the Campgrounds of the Florida District United Pentecostal Church Inc (FDUPCI) agree that all of their actions and attitudes will be in keeping with the sincerely held beliefs of the FDUPCI as recorded in the Holy Bible (KJV) and the Articles of Faith of the UPCI. By staying in any Dorm or room at the FDUPCI Campgrounds, you agree that while on this property, you will abide by all of the rules set forth and mentioned in this document, including the Holy Bible (KJV), UPCI Article of Faith, Dorm Policies and Youth Camp Rules, Regulations & Policies.

We hope you enjoy your stay at the Florida District Campgrounds. To help make your stay enjoyable, we ask that you help create and maintain a healthy community atmosphere in the dorm. Please read the following rules and agree to abide by them:

Registration

All guests must be registered and pay all appropriate fees, including a minimum of \$15 per person per night to stay in the dorm or any room on the property. **NO CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 12 WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER OR STAY IN THE DORM.**

Fire and Safety

All guests are required to follow these fire and safety regulations.

1. Open flames such as candles or incense are prohibited.
2. The moving of beds and furniture is prohibited (by Florida State laws) as the aisles and doors must remain accessible in the event of fire.
3. The following appliances are not allowed to be used in the dorms: appliances with open coils, such as toasters, grills, hot plates, roasters, crock pots, popcorn poppers, or any other cooking appliance. Cooking is strictly prohibited.
5. Extreme care should be taken with appliances such as curling irons, hair straighteners, hair dryers and irons. There are designated areas specified for ironing on ironing boards only (not on beds or carpet). Do not leave these items on when not in use.
6. The use of extension cords of any type are not permitted in the dorm, but you may use a power-strip if it has a built-in circuit breaker.

Maintenance and Damages

All guests share the responsibility to maintain the dorm. The responsibilities include:

1. Maintaining a clean environment in the dorm/room and its contents.
2. Reporting of damages or problems as soon as possible.
3. Appropriate arrangement of belongings to facilitate easy and lawful ingress and egress.
4. Immediate correction of unsafe or potentially hazardous conditions in the dorm/room (such as overloaded power outlets).
5. By Florida Laws all furniture must stay in its original position (including beds).
6. The bed you use and the area around it must be kept and left clean.
7. You are personally responsible for any damage or cleaning required as a result of your actions or your failure to take appropriate actions.

Quiet Hours

Guests must respect quiet hours.

1. At the posted “Quiet Hours” or when the staff turns the lights out, guests are expected and required to refrain from excessive noise and other disruptive activities.
2. Be aware that lights and sounds from phones, computers, iPads, etc. could affect others in the dorm. Please be courteous.

Food and Drink

1. All food/drink must be consumed outside of the dorm
2. You are required to keep all food/drink in your vehicle, if possible. If you are unable to keep food in your vehicle, food/drink must be kept inside a sealed container, such as a Ziploc bag, that is placed inside a zipped, sealed bag or suitcase, **but no food is to be consumed in the dorm** (with the exception of water and food for medical emergencies, including but not limited to, Diabetes).
3. Coolers are not allowed in the dorm and must be kept in your vehicle or outside.

Other Guests

Please be respectful of the rights and property of others. Report any suspicious activity to staff.

Interactions with Staff

Staff members will be placed in the dorm to oversee its operation. Staff members are obligated to report violations. They are not expected to tolerate abuse in the performance of their duties. Please be kind to the staff members if they ask you to correct any violations.

Staying in the dorm is a privilege and not a right, therefore anyone not keeping these rules or correcting violations may or will be asked to leave.
